

## Benchmark Frequencies for the BYU/UW Election Panel

The following tables give benchmark frequencies for the BYU/UW Panel, Wave 1. All frequencies are weighted by the variable “weight” to produce a nationally representative sample.

SPSS rounds the reported cell frequencies so there are occasional discrepancies between the individual table case totals and the correct weighted N of 2782.032. SPSS usually flags this and gives the correct weighted N in the “Case Processing Summary” table printed before the frequencies.

Users of the data should check that their weighted Ns are correct. Failure to weight the data can lead to incorrect results.
